



Kid's Craft Corner:

Design a COVID-Friendly Halloween Mask #RHMathome

Needed Materials: cotton mask

Suggested Materials: fabric paint, fabric markers, gems, sequins, thread for stitching or embroidery or anything that you can think of. Get creative!

Instructions:

1. Make sure that your mask has been washed and is dry before you begin decorating it.
2. Think about the design you want to create. I would suggest drawing it out on your mask first with a pencil, just so you have some guidelines for when you put the permanent decorations on it. You do not have to do this though.
3. Once you know what your design will be, gather your materials and start decorating. If you are gluing items on you can use regular school glue, but fabric glue or hot glue can be used as well. If you use hot glue, **make sure you have adult supervision.**
4. Once you have finished decorating it, let it dry for at least 24 hours before wearing it.
5. You now have your very own COVID-friendly Halloween mask!
